- To support in a positive manner all actions taken by the Board of Directors even when I am in a minority position on such actions.
- To agree to serve on at least one committee or task force, attend all meetings, and participate in the accomplishment of its objectives. If I chair the board, a committee, or task force, I will:
 - ◆ Call meetings as necessary until objectives are met.
 - ◆ Ensure that the agenda and support materials are mailed to all members in advance of the meetings.
 - ◆ Conduct the meetings in an orderly, fair, open and efficient manner.
 - ◆ Make committee progress reports to the board at its scheduled meeting.

- Community education, public relations, and resource development activities to attain NBPA strategic goals;
- Board development workshops, seminars, and other educational events that enhance my skills as a board member; and
- The NBPA's organizational retreat and Board self-evaluation programs.
